



Over 100 torturing methods are being used in prisons and labour camps in China today.

In June 2000, 18 Falun Gong women being held at the **Masanjia** Labour Camp were stripped naked and thrown into prison cells with violent male criminals, who were encouraged to rape and abuse the women.






How was it possible that live organ harvesting occurs in China?

- Dehumanization and the hatred against Falun Gong are the main underlying factors for the forced organ harvesting.
- Justification. Helping to eliminate "enemies of the Party"
- A business of high profit
- No risk.
 - Lawyers are instructed not to defend Falun Gong
 - It is the Party's order "to destroy [Falun Gong practitioners] physically"



Respect for human life?



"In rural areas, to kill the **reactionaries**, there should be over 1/1000 of the total population killed ... in the cities, it should be less than 1/1000"

Worldwide support

- 1999: Persecution of Falun Gong by the CCP | peaceful resistance from Falun Gong
- 2000: first report of organ harvesting from Falun Gong practitioners
- 2006: Matas & Kilgour report (52 kinds of evidence)
- 2008: Ethan Gutmann, "China's Gruesome Organ Harvest", Weekly Standard
- 2012 (June): A question added to the USCIS non-immigrant visa application form DS-160: It asks whether the applicant "has participated in forced human organ transplantation"
- 2012 (Sep.): a joint-subcommittee hearing was held in the US Congress addressing the forced organ harvesting practices in China
- 2012 (Dec.): DAFOH Petition to UN
 - in US: 30,000 signatures in 10 cities within 4 weeks
 - in Europe: 160,000 signatures
- 2013 (Jan.): Hearing in the European Parliament
- 2013 (April): Forum in the UK Parliament


